INTRODUCTION TO PUBLISHING

►► **PUBLISHING** : The creation, compilation and mass reproduction of graphic and text images making information available to the public.

Types of publishing : Publishing through print media, Publishing through electronic media

1. Publishing through Print Media

3 Stages : **1.1 Pre-press**, **1.2. Printing**, **1.3. Post press**

1.1 Pre-press : Making the document ready for printing.

Eg: Deciding the layout & size of page

DTP (DeskTop Publishing): It is the creation of page layouts for documents using DTP software. Eg: Scribus, Adobe InDesign, QuarkXPress, etc.

Pre-Press Activities

A.Designing, B.Pre-Flighting, C.Creating Proof, D.Printing Plates

1.1.A. Designing : It is the arrangement of visual elements in a page.

1.1.A.1. Elements of design

1.Line : To divide space and to draw attention. Direction of a line conveys mood.

2. Shape : Used to emphasize a portion of a page.

3. Color : Color creates a mood.

4. Space : Creates the feeling of actual depth.

5. Typography : It is the art and technique of arranging letters to make the document readable and beautiful.

**Two styles of fonts are:

Sans-serif: Fonts without feet.

Serif : Fonts with a little feet.

1.1.A.2. Principles of design : The concepts used to arrange the elements of design.

1. Balance: It is the distribution of visual weight of objects, colors, texture and space.

2. Repetition : Make artwork attractive by repeating patterns on the page.

3. Contrast : Association of opposite elements like color, tone, direction to highlight key elements.

4. Harmony : It is the visually satisfying effect of combining similar, related elements.

5. Unity : It refers to the visual linking of various elements of the work

6. Dominance : Gives emphasis to elements on the page by giving them color and size.

1.1.B Pre-Flighting : Activity to ensure that all necessary elements are contained in the page.

**Process of making a document ready for printing is : Prepress / Pre-fighting / Designing

1.1.C. Creating Proof : It visualizes how the finished design will appear when printed.

1.1.D. Printing plates : Objects to be printed on pages become images on the printing plate.
Used in off-set presses.

1.2 PRINTING

1.2.1. Lithographic printing : It is an offset printing technique using plates & also popular for commercial printing of newspapers, books.

1.2.2. Digital printing : Image editing is possible as there are no printing plates.

Cost and quality are higher than lithographic print. ***CMYK** - Cyan,Magenta,Yellow, Key (black)

1.2.3. Gravure printing : It is used in package printing. Print on material like polyester,nylon aluminum foil,paper etc.It has low cost and good quality. Eg: Lays Cover.

1.2.4. Flexography : It is a widely used method for printing on packaging materials such as films,Labels,cardboard boxes, bags, and flexible packaging .

1.2.5. Screen printing : It uses a woven mesh to support an ink blocking stencil to receive a desired image. Print on paper, plastic ,glass ,metals, fabrics etc.

1.3 Post press

1.3.1. Folding : Method of folding the printed pages.

1.3.2. Assembling : Arranging printed pages in correct order.

1.3.3. Binding : Binding techniques are hard cover binding ,punch and binding thermally activated binding ,stitched binding etc

1.3.4. Cutting : Cutting is done according to the crop marks printed on the paper.

2.Publishing through Electronic Media

It is the digital publishing of e-books,digital magazines and the development of digital libraries and catalogs.

2.1 Two type of electronic publishing ?

2.1.1 Web based publishing : It is the process of publishing the content on the Internet. Users can browse and read.

Eg: wikipedia, online newspapers, blog etc.

2.1.2. Digital distribution / Digital Publishing: These documents are downloadable & can be read using e-reading devices. Eg: e-books, e-journals etc.

2.2. e-book reader : It is a portable electronic device for reading digital books.
